



New Hampshire National Guard Tuition Waiver Program at Granite State College

Thanks for your interest in Granite State College. For your convenience, here's an overview of the Tuition Waiver Program (RSA 110-B:63). In appreciation for your service to the country, Granite State College funds this program directly. We do not receive reimbursement for the classes you take.

- The Tuition Waiver Program is for those serving in the New Hampshire Air National or Army National Guard
- NH National Guard members residing out-of-state are eligible for in-state tuition rates
- Granite State College tuition is waived for students who are eligible for the program
 - *Tuition waived for space available credit courses only (tuition is not waived for Independent Learning Contracts)*
 - *Fees are not waived (this includes degree application, registration, academic services, materials, graduation and prior learning fees)*

To be eligible, here's what you need to do...

- Be admitted to a GSC degree program
- Apply for all other forms of assistance
- NG Scholarship – apply annually before June 1st
 - *Apply for all other federal entitlements (for details please check with your Education Coordinator)*
 - *Federal Tuition Assistance – apply each term*
 - *If eligible, apply for Chapter 33 POST 9/11 GI Bill®*
 - *It is recommended the guard member annually apply for federal and state grants via the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) www.fafsa.ed.gov*
- Send completed and signed National Guard Waiver Form from the Guard Education Office to either your nearest GSC campus or the Student Accounts Office in Concord. This form must be submitted each term you plan to attend
- Pay all fees by due date for each term

If courses fill, here's what you need to do...

If the course(s) for which you are registered fills, the tuition waiver will not be available. You will be notified. However, there are options for you:

- You may pay for the course to secure your seat. You may use grants and scholarships and loans awarded to you to help cover the cost of the course.
- You may be added to the waitlist for the course. Your waiver eligibility will be determined prior to the start of the course.
- You may drop the course and choose another.
