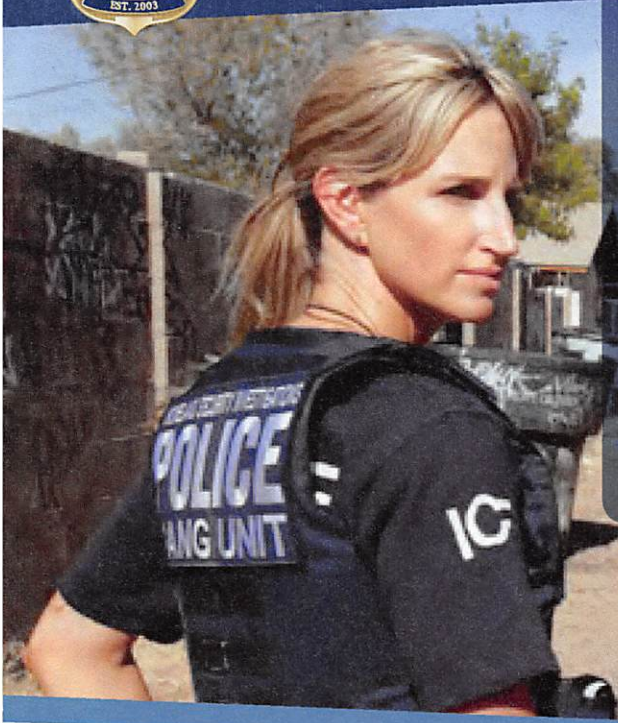




LAW ENFORCEMENT PROFESSIONALS WORK at ICE
