Telephone Interviewer Positions

The University of New Hampshire offers survey research services to sponsors in government, academia, business, and the non-profit sector. We conduct telephone interviews for research studies using a computer-assisted telephone interviewing system. We do not sell anything or ask for any money.

Interviewers are required to work a minimum of three, 4-hour shifts per week, with at least one of the shifts on a weekend. Interviewers are responsible for setting up a schedule that will be maintained for the semester. Schedules may be adjusted with supervisor approval. Typical shifts are Monday through Friday from 5pm to 9pm, Saturdays 10am to 2pm or 2pm to 6pm, and Sundays 1pm to 5pm or 5pm to 9pm; however, the days/hours available to work may vary project by project. This is a part-time position with work hours available only when the UNH Survey Center has a telephone survey project in the field.
