Note: This degree requires an earned associate degree or its equivalent in transfer to GSC. This sample schedule assumes 68 credits in transfer and General Education transfer credit for one of two Science requirements, one Global Perspectives course requirement, and one History and Politics course requirement. Since students may transfer up to 78 credits, most programs in Applied Studies will allow more associate degree transfer courses to fulfill requirements at Granite State College (resulting in fewer terms to degree completion).
