


## Granite State College Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice- Curriculum Map

Background checks are completed for most positions in the field of criminal justice, and normally also required for any internship. Applicants or current students who have had arrests or convictions may not be eligible for employment. Opportunities for a career in Criminal Justice and closely related fields will require that individuals demonstrate the required psychological, personal, and legal qualifications.
