The Osher Reentry Scholarship Endowment, sponsored by the Bernard Osher Foundation, is designed to provide students tuition assistance (up to \$3000) during the 2018-2019 academic year. These scholarships are designed to provide financial assistance to eligible "reentry" Granite State College (GSC) students who are pursuing their first bachelor's degree.

A "reentry student" is a person who has experienced a cumulative gap of five or more years during their formal education and has not yet completed the requirements for a bachelor's degree. *If you are a returning Osher Reentry Scholar and would like to reapply for the Osher Reentry Scholarship Endowment, please complete the application for "Returning Osher Reentry Scholars" available at: www.granite.edu/financial-aid-forms.*

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a reentry student preferably between the ages of 25 and 50, and currently enrolled either full or half time in a bachelor's degree program at GSC.
- Must have experienced a cumulative gap of 5 years or more during the pursuit of formal education and anticipate a significant number of years of workforce participation.
- Must maintain a 3.0 GPA. (GPA will be reviewed at time of application each year).
- Must NOT be taking exclusively online classes.
- Must NOT be a USNH employee using a tuition waiver.
